- Water Leaks throughout Village

Water/Sewer

- Water leak at Cemetery- shared services with Manheim repairing the leak in their Cemetery.
- Snail setup- Removed barriers from trail to erect a collection bin for snails. Used the rental

sweeper to vacuum the snail out of the solids contact tank.

- Drain issue at Youth Center- Drain runs slow due to old piping and multiple uses at the same time.
- McKinley water issue- used excess pavement to cover pull off area to keep debris from running into Mckinnley during high water events.
- Mowed up at water and delivered filter bags.
- Reset driveways at WTP and Reservoir- post paving Salisbury.
- 5 Wolf St- Used camera-checking integrity of pipe before new house is placed.
- Paved walkways at WTP.
- Cleaned filter at WTP.
- 54 S. Helmer- Used Camera- preventative measure-Resident was worried his line may need replacement.
- Hauled and setup Pumps and Equipment for bypass at reservoir.
- Checked valve at Rawlings-has internal leak, checked our valve to make sure it shut down.
- Howard St Sewer- Complaint that water was coming through homeowner's wall. Nothing was found.
- Reservoir cleaned
- Hydrant #34 was forcibly removed by an automobile post Storm #1. The valve to the hydrant was shut off, the shoe "bottom" was found to be in good condition. A top was removed from a new hydrant in stock and put into service, reinstating hydrant. The existing hydrant is in the process of being rehabbed.
