# Water/Sewer

- Caulfield Project- 271 feet of 8-inch pipe, 4 incorporation points, 2 laterals and 1 manhole set has been installed. 250 feet of ditch refilled and road restored. We will be checking back in, in case of any sinkage in the area.
- Bus Garage (School)- Located sewer.
- Brockett Rd- Investigated water leak, found a leak on the private line, informed the line owners and a private contractor repaired.
- All lists presented for Lead survey have been located.
- Cleaned filter for Neil
- Elm St Sewer Complaint/Sewer plug. Multiple plugs multiple times. Contacted Amy about bringing in a crew to televise that portion of Main.
- Jetted school cafeteria line- Found a pair of scissors last year, still in the line. Removed several vape cartridges and a bottle of perfume.
- Salvaging hard to find Brass parts from N.
  Main St and refurbishing recoverable curb boxes.

#### **Streets**

- Removed vegetation from around the houses on North Main St.
- Salting and training Employees on Salter
- Plowing has started and training Employees on Plowing.
- Delivered Salt to Seniors
- Leaves- when piles are found leaves will be picked up.
- Took Street decorations out of storage, replaced bulbs as needed, put up decorations.
- Put up decorations at Village Hall.
- Picked up leaves and Pumpkins
- Cleaning up leaves and Debris before snow.
- Ordered salt
- Filled out application for renewal of mine permit.
- Put flags back up- They were at half various times this month.

# Garage

- "09" Freightliner- Replaced main air feed line and repaired 2 coolant lines.
- 550 Will need new tires and installed new cutting edge.

- F350- will need front brakes and removed leaf box.
- 3500- no new issues
- 12 Freightliner- no new issues
- Roller- fuel tank became dislodged, will need repair
- Loader- no new issues
- Leaf Picker- no new issues
- Sweeper- recommend eliminating this unit, as soon as time permits, it will be sent to scrap yard.
- Sewer Jet- no new issues
- Skid Steer- No new issues
- Excavator- No new issues
- Monthly Fuel Tank Check and inspections
- Snowman- needs u bolt repair, front end work, cab floor is shot, inner and outer rockers are gone, as discussed at last months meeting
- Back Hoe- front tire repaired.
- Fuel tank Gauges- Buell stopped and started the process of installing- ongoing- still not complete
- Cable is still out, that needs to be addressed in the office and I have requested this- spoke with Kathy about it
- 60-inch Mower-no new issues
- Water cart- in mechanics bay, when time permits, we will repair axle before sourcing new bearings for the wheels.
- 71" mower- no new issues

- Still in the process of cleaning the garage when time permits.
- Cleaning up and reorganizing the salt shed area.
- Painting at Village Hall- the process has started; I am expecting to use this as fill-in work as we get further into winter.
- PD car 609- Removed lights, radios and cage in preparation for sale. Decals as well.

#### **Parks**

- Greenway Trail- will be opening soon for snow mobiling
- Plowe Park- sourced tree, decorated Gazebo and tree. 4 more trees down, brush has been removed, tree bases will be removed when the ground firms up.
- Center Park- Hauling in material from Timmerman St to complete landscaping at the bottom (Where pavilion use to be).

- Little League Field- water was shut off, sewer pump removed.
