- Weekly Checks of Sewers
- Daily 811 Requests

Water/Sewer

- Water Leak- State St- 1st time we dug at both ends to find the leak and were unsuccessful.
 We ended up replacing the entire service due to the leak and found multiple breaks in the line IE: Compression fittings. Researched several options to not dig up the entire street. None were successful. The street was cut across and dug up. A new service line was installed.
- Water turn on Hopson Rd.
- Checked Main St Sewer- no blockages.
 Associated with 97 North Main- Stewarts.
 Went back again. The problem is in the lateral, they cleared it through inhouse with their plumber. We advised them to close their restroom to the public, have not heard back since. Checked in and doesn't seem to be any issues.
- Investigated and Confirmed water leak 231 Helmer Ave. Found 2 shut offs. Shut off closest to main is nonfunctional and the shutoff nearest the house was the source of the leak. While digging it, we dug up the line, breaking it due to it being plastic and no tracer wire. We didn't carry parts for 1 inch plastic. We had to go to Utica to source parts to a allow our compression fitting to be used on plastic pipe.

- Sewer plug on Main St (Library). Ongoing.
 Waiting on final disposition on weather the dig is ours. Have informed them to start their process as far as attaining quotes per their procurement policy to get things moving.
 Informed them to close their bathrooms until resolved.
- Pulled Bricks and Debris from manhole on S.
 Main St. Bagged the sewer and cleared it.
- New water leak- North Helmer- Rawlings in the area of the kilns. It is a 6-to-8-inch valve leaking through the packings. It is their valve. Working with Rawlings to resolve issue.
- Water Main Break at Stewart St. Straight forward chased leak down, repaired pipe, was done live and is back filled and corrected.
- Sewer Complaint 20 VanBuren- The
 plumbing was done where there was no
 internal cleanout and no place to insert a
 sewer bag or camera to relieve the issue.
 Advised her to call a plumber. Also found an
 open 4-inch cast sewer line under her porch.
 I have a picture of it.
- Water Leak at MOVAC- heat went out on one side of the building. The water line inside the building froze. We were called to shut the water off going into the building. Curb stop is broken. Aided them in fixing the leak live.

- Checked village for water leak- advised
 Village residents to listen for pipes. Leak was found on West Spofford Ave. Homeowner resolved issue with their house.
- Looked for Manhole #1 at WWTP. Due to the amount of metal debris in the area, our metal detector could not find the metal lid. We worked off of previous measurements with no luck. Brought in the sewer jet, attached our camera and attempted to locate with no luck. Attached a metal cable, attached our water tracer with no luck. Rural water attempted to help us with no luck. Advised Amy to bring in the camera truck to help us locate. We will be onsite and ready to dig.
- Investigated Water problem at PD- Leaking shower. Replaced seats and springs and the shower head.

- Filled hole in Cline St (Grid)
- Picked up Christmas Trees- We have 1 more round to do.
- Regular Salting and plowing of streets.
- Cold Patched all cuts made for water leaks.
- Cold Patching throughout the village
