#### Current

- Weekly Checks of Sewers

## Water/Sewer

- State St- Checked sewer with camera. Sewer was replaced by homeowner, still water in line. Advised that water needed to be removed and haven't heard back.
- Checked sewers around the Village
- Repaired hydrant Bonet and replaced.
- Cleaned Filter
- Sewer back up- In Garage. It was relieved in house.
- Sewer back up at School- Kitchen line backed up; employees called back in as it was after work hours. Ran the line with the sewer jet and blockage was relieved.
- Tricot's fire Hydrant needs to be replacedtowards spring.
- Loaded Polymer for Amy

#### **Streets**

- Checking of storm drains for debris and snow removal on them.
- Took care of Parking lots and sidewalks at parks when we had snow.
- Pushed back road edges

## Garage

- Loader- in the process of removing debris from summer use. Upgraded lighting to LED and Cutting edge put on.
- Leaf Picker- no new issues
- Sewer Jet- no new issues
- Skid Steer- tires replaced. Had tires in stock from old machine
- Excavator- will be serviced when time permits, bushings in the bucket will need to be replaced
- Monthly Fuel Tank Check and inspections
- Snowman-Still has body and frontend issues.
   Replaced water pump
- Back Hoe- no new issues
- Fuel tank Gauges- Buell stopped and started the process of installing- ongoing- still not complete- Again called and made contactthey assured me they were there and I sent pictures showing they were not. They will be

- looking into the best way to get the project done hopefully within the next month.
- Cable is still out, still an issue. Called Spectrum on multiple occasions. Apparently, cable at the garage was discontinued. It will need to be rectified by whoever deals with the cable.

## **Parks**

- Center Park- Hauled in millings to level and grade parking area and repair damaged portions of road in the area.
- Little League Field- Working on reconnecting power after tree work
- Beavers-Tricot- no new signs of beaver activity
- Helterline- Pulled the last 2 benches. They are in the process of disassembling and cleaning in preparation for paint.

## North Main St

- 121 and 123 Water disconnects and National Grid.
- Working on grade work on the creek side with removal of scrap metal.
- Aiding the asbestos abatement crew, (Leveling ground, moving dumpsters and getting water from hydrant and whatever else they need)
- Loader was sent to Salisbury to open up Upper Irondale Road so we can access our Mine and haul material to back fill foundations.
