Water/Sewer

- Filter bag project complete, filter bags set and reservoir cleaned.
- Installation of new water service-McKinnley
- 11 Vanburen St-Led survey
- Mowing of WTP and Reservoir
- Sent 1 man to WWTP with Bobcat for snail removal.
- 20 Van Buren-Curb stop dig- Galvanized found and line replacement required.
- Met with Caulfield- Water Tap application and Sewer tap Application coming.
- Plugged Sewer on Howard St- Plug was alleviated using the jetted. Issue seems to be resolved.
- Plugged Sewer Spofford Ave "Grease"- Plug resolved and line jetted.
- Jet and Clean Schuyler St- Sewar Complaint of plugged lateral. Checked Sewer, all appeared fine, jetted to be sure and alleviate any problems to the home owner.
- Water Leak and Curb Stop- 17 Wolf St- A shut off was requested to repair valve inside house. Curb stop found to be inoperable, dug to replace curb stop, in the process the soldered joints cracked creating a small leak. The pipe was cut, repaired live, line was reinstated and new curb stop and box installed.

- Storm Drain complaint- Bever Brook @ Van Buren- Car hit a raised storm drain due to milling. Cover became dislodged and we reinstated it.
- Water shut offs- Can discuss if the Board desires as well as Turn On's.
