Water/Sewer

- Repaired leaking valves on Hydrant Repaired on Winton Lane.

- Went to Middleville to observe a water leak detecting Dog.

Streets

- Green Waste trucks being sent out upon request on weekends and weekdays.
- Showed up to Rundell St to remove garbage and Homeowner removed it themselves.
- School Banner put up
- Cold Patching throughout the Village.
- Milling on State, Dunkel and Bocket
- Filled in Driveways and set cones for Milling.
- Seal Coating is done.
- Milling for this years paving season is done.

Garage

- “09” Freightliner- multiple issues- need to consider replacement. Power issues, truck currently won’t start. We will investigate further.
- 3500- nothing new
- 12 Freightliner- has a front-end issue. We are investigating avenues of repair.
- 550- nothing new
- Roller- will be brought in to do repairs shortly
- Loader- nothing new
- Leaf Picker- no new issues
- Sewer Jet- no new issues
- Skid Steer- Currently at Warner Sales for a foot pedal sensor issue. They dropped off a slightly smaller replacement. It is a warranty repair. FYI- Warranty is off June 25th.

- Excavator- still needs bushings in the bucket. It needs a repair in the track drive controls. The handle for the left side track can randomly come loose and the track stops moving, turning the machine without warning. Parts are on order. Unit overheats when using the high speed.
- Monthly Fuel Tank Check and inspections
- Snowman-Still has body and frontend issues.
- Back Hoe- no new issues
- Fuel tank Gauges- have arrived and are installed.
- Cable is still out, still an issue. Called Spectrum on multiple occasions. Apparently, cable at the garage was discontinued. It will need to be rectified by whoever deals with the cable. - Still out
- 60" Mower- randomly dropped a blade, both blade and both recovered. They were reunited and are in back in service.
- Water cart- found new tires and wheels. Purchased 4 at Tractor Supply. We should probably get an account there. Tires and Wheels on.
- 71" mower-blew a fuel pump fuse. We had to tow it back to the garage and we found the problem. Problem repaired and back in service.
- Garage cleaning is ongoing.
- Shared services with Manheim- they borrowed chipper- still out
- Working on FCC Radio License-Ongoing
- Back end of the Garage roof became detached during a wind storm causing damage. Insurance has been notified. Mohawk Valley Coatings has been called, Quote is in. They did the last roof

repair; it makes sense to continue to use their system.

Parks

- Greenway Trail- Graded, rolled and open
- Plowe Park- Mowing done
- Center Park- Contractors have been in working on basketball court.
- Little League Field- nothing new
- Beavers-Tricot- no new signs of beaver activity- Beavers have moved down stream to the end of Spofford Ave and they are building a dam just past our Culvert. We will be removing Beavers. I will look into the legalities and see what is needed for a permit.
- Helterline- mowed and garbage's removed.
- Luther Park-

- Keeping up with force logs
- Hauling in material, filling in low spots and grading.
- The last of the topsoil has been delivered, laid out and graded.
- All debris has been removed
- Hydroseeding is to happen Monday June 17th.

Violet Festival-

- Plowe park outlets tested and repaired. It was found that most of the Gazebo outlets are on the same fuse, we will need to rectify that.

- 200 No parking signs were purchased and set out.
- DOT and Herkimer County were in with Sweepers.
- Worked with PD for Barricade locations.
- Barricades were put into place
- I heard of no Parking issues this year
- Parade went well, aided PD with trucks at 3 different locations.
- FD loaned radios for Communication.
