Water/Sewer

- Flushed West Timmerman Sewer
- Debris removal from Bever Brook (Wall Collapse). Placed Plywood wall in so Creek water running by won't erode bank causing issues to parking lot. This is a temporary fix. Painted Yellow lines and placed Barrels to keep people away from area.
- S. Main Water Main Break- This is the second hole I found in the pipe in 16 years of service. This is a fairly alarming trend. We may have to discuss some options if this continues. The hole was a little larger than a Stewarts Coffee cup in both length and width. Repaired.
- Cleared snow at WWTP.
- Flushed North Main St Sewer-2 weeks in a row. Found large amounts of waste in line.
 We will continue to keep an eye on it.
- Jetted Schuyler St Sewer
- Met with Amy for Pump Delivery and unloaded Pumps and hoses for her.
- Found Manhole 1
- Filled State St and Stewart St Dig Sites.
- Advised KPI to keep bypass line as far to curb as possible for plowing operations. Advised School bus garage of Bypass, and advised county. WWTP sewer lining.

Streets

- Called State about Stop signs- They came in and replaced theirs on Main St.
- On Vanburen St Ext we added millings to fill in potholes. We went around and cold Patched potholes around the Village.
- Pushed snowbanks at Kinney's as well as removed snow from the lot. Throughout the Village we removed snow as well.
- Spoke with Rawlings and Woodshop on McKinnley about Plowing Issues "Blocking Street". Resolved.
- Sidewalk Complain- S. Main- Complaint on Odd side of St. There is no sidewalk in that area. Did research the sidewalk law. Due to how late in the year it is, I don't believe it is enforceable but we need to get word out before next year and enforce then if the board so chooses.
- Filled in water leak dig ahead of the storm.
- Took an invert start on Sullivan St for the DDSO.

- "09" Freightliner- Cleaned Battery
 Connections, Bad ground to frame-fixed. Bad
 battery Switch- fixed. Connections are
 corroding away on fuse box for auxiliary
 equipment. Engine was shutting off while
 driving and it will need rear brakes. The wing
 was damaged while plowing. A new to us
 wing was installed at no charge to
 Taxpayers. General Maintenance.
- 550 Broken Cutting edge- I believe it is a design flaw in the cutting edge. It seems to be breaking in the same place time after time. Replaced 1 spot light on salter (Bulb). General Maintenance.
- F350- no new issues
- 3500- no new issues
- 12 Freightliner- Had to replace a salter light.
- Leaf Picker- in storage
- Sweeper-same issues
