Water/Sewer

- Flushed Schuyler St-nothing found.
- Water leak in Middleville- Middleville's water
 Dept reached out to us to help them with a dig.
 We sent the excavator, truck and trailer and 2 guys.
- Installed drainage pipe on Timmerman St.
- Cleared Culverts at WTP
- Culvert repair on Stewart St along with ditching.
- Tracing lines on N. Helmer Ave to locate water valve to Kinney's. Found and installed riser on Kinney's valve. Assisted crew inside the building helping to avoid flooding and keep the business open.
- Fixed leaking fire hydrant Bonnet on North Main St.
- Emergency Hydrant Replacement on Lamberson St. At 0200 Hours, the Fire Dept was called out to a motor Vehicle accident. A Car "apparently' swerved to miss an animal, struck a street sign, became airborne and struck hydrant #61 shearing off the hydrant. As soon as the car was removed the valve was located. Due to the leak the light sediment made it impossible to locate the bonnet nut on the valve. A dig was called and crews were brought in. As soon as 811 cleared the dig, we exposed the hydrant broken off at the shoe. In the process residual pressure pushed the valve we had shut off, off its seat. This required a valve and hydrant replacement. We will be billing the

Insurance company for all parts, pieces, hours, machinery and lost water.

Ran traffic control for B&L.

- Placed a barrel light on S. Main St. Filled in the Manhole with millings and cold patched over the top.
- Cleaned State St. A haul truck dropped some of its load throughout the Village. I received a complaint.

- "09" Freightliner- multiple issues- need to consider replacement. Took off the Plow equipment.
