Water/Sewer

- Hydrant Training
- Cleaned water filter and back washed another day.

- Brighton Court Sewer-installed custom end manhole. Set manhole lid.
- Water meter installed at Bus Garage
- Kinney's storm drain- Raised up to level the parking lot.
- Cleaned valve at Fire Station
- Helped water with Plate for finished water line to aid back flushing.
- N. Main St Flushed sewer to remove buildup in sewer line.
- Installed a water meter at Rawlings.
- Jetted sewer at Brighton Ct and Schuyler St.
- Replaced Chlorine Cylinder.
- Water Shutoffs complete along with turn-ons.

Streets

- Missing banner was on Howard St and hardware is intact, we are still looking for banner.
- Green waste still ongoing
- Leaf picking all Month
- Christmas lights were pulled down and are 98% working. Not enough bulbs were ordered, more on order. I expect them done before the end of next week.
- 601- parking in different places throughout the village to aid the PD in speed deterrence.

Garage

- “09” Freightliner-Carbon Tech treatment complete, Rust control on the chassis and met with Rob about potential replacement.
- 3500- nothing new
- 12 Freightliner- King pins were replaced, rust controlled, fittings reinstalled for winter service, Carbon tech treatment complete, salter was installed and serviced, under carriage was painted.
- 550- tailgate was removed in preparation for winter service, cutting edge for 10’ V-plow was replaced and returned spring for mold board replaced.
- Roller- nothing new
- Loader- carbon tech treatment completed and rust control done.
- Leaf Picker- no new issues
- Sewer Jet- no new issues
- Skid Steer- no new issues
- Excavator- still needs bushings in the bucket. Drive, still has a random overheating issue.
- Monthly Fuel Tank Check and inspections
- Snowman-is out of service.
- Back Hoe- no new issues
- Army Truck/530- Push plates installed, wiring harness installed, transfer tank installed in bed, still fighting electrical gremlins with the lights due to the plow harness.
- Fuel tank Gauges- ok

- 60" Mower- no new issues
- Water cart- out of service for the season
- 71" mower-no new issues
- Garage cleaning is ongoing.
- Shared services with Manheim- they borrowed chipper- still out
- Garage roof, they came back and did some touchup work.
- Village Hall- helped repair a window at village hall.
- Prepped driveway at Garage for repair- Cleaning and removing debris and repaired the driveway.
- New tire machine picked up and has been retro fit to work in the garage. This will allow us to mount larger tires cutting down costs. Old machine couldn't do anything above a 17" steel wheel. This one does up to 24".

Parks

- Greenway Trail- nothing new
- Plowe Park- nothing new
- Center Park- found an utterly disgusting toilet, a set of keys was found hanging on the outside of the building and the guts were removed out of one of the doors. Pumpkins and other assorted debris were removed from the toilet. Toilet was flushed and RV antifreeze added and reset for winter. A door was ordered and replaced. The building will be rekeyed so there should be only 1 key to open any door on the building. The basketball court is closed for the season.

Damage was found to both sets of doors and 1 lock was forcibly removed. Several trips have been made to walk the grounds and clean the park.

- Little League Field- nothing new
- Beavers-Tricot- I believe 3 beavers were removed from Tricot Pond.
- Beavers-Dolge Ave- An additional 6 removed, not sure where all came from. An ongoing effort. As soon as beavers in both places are removed, Dams will be opened up allowing water to flow.
