- Installed 10" Drain pipe/Extended 6" feed pipe for screen house.
- Ran and picked up (Reservoir) Parts
- Final assembly of bypass complete.
- Reset bag manifold at (Reservoir)
- Dug Sumps for Pumps (Reservoir)
- Removed trees along fence line (Reservoir)
- Attempted to lessen the leak from valve on Lamberson@ Ransom. Valve is broken.
 Missing retaining nut was replaced and lock tight applied, valve reassembled and still in service.
- Removed transfer tank for Neil.
- Checked and cleared storm drains around the village.
