1. PERMIT COMPLIANCE FOR SEPTEMBER 2024

All limits, levels and monitoring requirements were met.

2. MAINTENANCE

- Normal Preventive Maintenance
- 2 Gas unit heaters need replacing – ongoing
- Trojan Energy performed boiler cleaning/inspection
- Fall yard work, trimming back vegetation along fence line, winter prep

3. ASSISTANT OPERATOR

Operator trainee passed his Grade 2A certification exam on Oct. 18 and is now the Assistant Operator.

4. LCRR

Assisting Neal with LCRR compliance and letters to consumers regarding lead and galvanized service line replacements.

5. EPA WATER TA (No update)

Neal and I submitted an interest form to EPA for their programs related to water and sewer engineering services and funding source assistance. This is a free service providing engineering for preliminary engineering reports needed to apply for project funding. Technical assistant teams then help communities seek funding for their projects. We are waiting to hear back.

6. MAIN ST SEWER PROJECT

Project was advertised on November 1. A pre-bid meeting (non-mandatory) was held 11/12. Bids are due on 12/5 and anticipate awarding bid at December 16 regular Board meeting.

7. DWSP2

Attended DWSP2 meeting 11/12. Herkimer Oneida Counties Comprehensive Planning Board (HOCCPB) prepared a draft Drinking Water Source Protection Plan for review based on input from the stakeholder group. The plan will be finalized over the next few months. The group composed of representatives from the Village and Town of Salisbury with assistance from the HOCCPB are working on a plan to better protect the Mang and Cold Brook water sheds and ensure future drinking water quality.
