- Inventoried Water meter Supplies
- Checked Ina's Pizza for Meter Install
- Checked Brix Pizza about a Meter Install
- Installed a meter at 175 South Main- Residential.
- Found potential water leak at W. State St. Called in and dug. Found to be ground water.
- Called in dig for 83 South Main St. Disconnect for demolition.
- Alerted by Grid to a previously unknown water service at 14 Elm St.
- Sewer Complaint W. Timmerman- Flushed the line-Resolved.
- Send loader to Salisbury to open Water Treatment Plant and the State Rt 29 Hydrant.
