- Removed excess material from water leak site on South Helmer.
- Cleaned filter 1 at Water Treatment plant.

- Water disconnects 83 North Main for Demolition.
- Correlated North Helmer Ave looking for a water leak. Dug leak and removed from service.
- Doing rounds with Neal and learning about the Water plant.

- 3500- check engine light is on from the Evap code.
- 12 Freightliner- had a radiator clamp failure, it was repaired and refilled.
- 550- We installed stop turn tail lamps in the upper part of the back of the box. Adjusted the salt chain. Keeping the truck empty of salt to protect the box and washed as much as possible.
