Water/Sewer

- Checked sewers for excessive flow and took notes for Amy.
- Kept an eye on Dolge Ave sewer during ice jamming.
- Used a camera on 71 Dolge Ave

- Met with Amy and Amber on Vac Truck found on “municabid”
- Checked for possible water leak in Salisbury, no chlorine residual found.
- 2010 hydrant testing put into the computer
- Spoke with Herkimer County legislature about possible help with grant funding for Vac truck.
- Used camera on VanBuren St
- Met with Neil on moving a hydrant on S. Main St.
- Marked out an emergency sewer dig on 10 Spencer St.
- Met with Carver about 2 Brothers service line
- Met with Amy on sewer jets
- Located curb stop on Emmonsberg Road
- Reassembled a fire hydrant at the garage for stock
- Met with Amy about S. Main St
- Car wash meter repair
- Met with Carver about a second landing site
- Water leak on North Main St.
- Worked with Rick Barnes to resolve a water leak in Salisbury
- Investigated one of the fire hydrants on N. Main St- it is the wrong style.
- Marked out S. Main St for Carver.
- Turned on new Main on North Main St.
- Investigated and repaired water leak on S. Main St.
- Investigated water service on 18 Howard
- Water testing on North Main St
- Water sampling of North Main St.
- Clean water valves on South Main St
- Marked out Elm and Baker St
- Water turn on 14 E. Spofford

- Training on new sewer jet to get familiar with it.
- Took loader to Waste Water for Amy

- Checked VanBuren and Faville Ave for surcharging
- Installed hydrant at Plowe park
- Cleaned 3 filters this month
- Took multiple samples from Elm St while Carver was digging to check for chlorine.
- Submitted a bill for new sewer jet and sent Vin for Insurance
- Cleaned more water valves on Helmer Ave.
- Put in 2011 hydrant testing into the computer.
- Shared information with Fire District
- Sewer complaint Kinney Drugs, main found to be clear and found to be an internal issue.
- Exploratory dig on E Faville to repair a valve. -needs to be replaced.
- Jetted sewer line on South Helmer Ave
- Jetted a storm drain on Dolge Ave
- Met with Eric Darling to confirm lateral location on Elm St
- Investigated a water leak at North Hudson- Chlorine present
- Shut off water on 10 Lamberson St.
- In the process of researching ways of eliminating incorporation gaskets.
- Met with udig about upcoming digs
- Ordered and received a battery for Neils pump and charged unit.
- Water shut off list
- Met with Carver about Fulton County water line
- Helped Neil set up back flush for filter

- Water turn On's
- Shut down North Main st water for Carver
- Flushing on Fulton County side
- Exploratory dig for South Main St fire hydrant and discussed options with Neil.
- Met with DOT about S Main St Storm drains due to exploratory dig for the hydrant.
- Led and Copper Dig 111 South Main St.

Streets

- Ran for 2 loads of Cold Patch
- Shut down VanBuren St from Mutchler to Second St due to ice flows.
- Checked creeks north of the Village periodically
- Checked flows on VanBuren and Dolge Ave
- Cold patching throughout the village
- Picked up and removed fallen banners and replaced
- Checked and test ran chain saws ahead of windy weather.
- Checked roads
- Salted and Scraped roads
- Put in Violet festival permit
- Cleaned storm drains
- 811 requests
- Striping Kinney's parking lot
- Made contact with school about traffic patterns ahead of sewer project
- Kept 911 center advised on traffic patterns in village for emergency services

- Put up no parking signs on Spencer St
- Storm drain complaint on 107 South Main- drain cleared
- Looked at sink hole on Helmer Ave-measured granite curbing at garage for sinkhole repair.
- School salt sheet turned in to Amber
- Investigated a complaint of collapsing creek banks on Beaver Brook between Main and Howard St ext.
- Checked creeks for flooding after heavy rains
- Cleared tree from roadway on St rt 29 coming into the Village
- Repaired broken stop sign on North Main St.
- Started green waste
- Have been putting trucks out for green waste the last couple weeks.
- Quoted paving for 2026
- Investigated sinking road complaint on VanBuren St Ext- found road to be sinking. Researched past repairs. Marked out and called in digs for VanBuren St.
- Marked out Elm st and called in for first set of storm drains and curb box repair.
- Worked on the hilltop dump road, smoothing and filling in holes.
- Filled out PO's and ordered stone for VanBuren St and Elm St repair.
- Removed poles on bank behind Masonic Home
- Met with Carver on storm drain on Main/Slawson

Garage

- “09” Freightliner- The Truck needs to be replaced-pressure washed and worked on minor air leaks
- 3500- washed and greased
- 12 Freightliner- pressure washed
- 550- salter was removed and cleaned for storage
- Roller- brought in and oil drained and filters ordered
- Loader- nothing new
- Leaf Picker-nothing new
- Sewer Jet- replaced and new one in service/
* Skid Steer-cleaned greased and bob tac serviced.
- Excavator- new bushings at the bucket on the dipper arm, cleaned and greased
