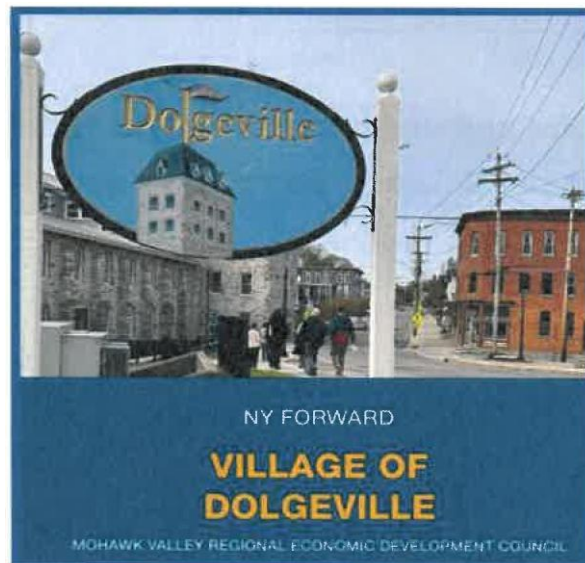

The Village of Dolgeville, in partnership with the NYS Housing Trust Fund Corporation (HTFC), is pleased to announce the opening of **ROUND 2** of the **Small Projects Fund**, made possible through a NY Forward Grant awarded by the State. This initiative is designed to support the revitalization of Dolgeville's Main Street by providing financial and technical assistance to eligible property and business owners within the NY Forward Target Area.

The Small Projects Fund will help bridge funding gaps for building facade and storefront renovations, business startup and expansion projects, and other improvements that contribute to the vibrancy and economic growth of the Village's Main Street core.

Priority will be given to projects that:

- *Are visually prominent in the downtown area*
- *Include renovation of upper-story apartments*
- *Preserve, reuse and promote historic buildings*
- *Help reduce blight and/or stabilize or help grow a small business*
- *Will create jobs*



How to Apply

Applications must be submitted by current property or business owners located within the NY Forward Target Area (refer to the attached map). All second round Applications submitted by the deadline below will be evaluated by the Village's project review committee for eligibility, impact, and alignment with local revitalization and NY Forward Program priorities.
